

EXPRESSION OF INTEREST

PAE MOTUHAKE FOR TE KĀHUI Ā-ROHE O NGĀ IWI O MĀTAATUA

Kia ūkaipō anō te reo Māori: "Te reo Māori is restored as a nurturing first language"

This is the vision of a Māori language strategy called the Maihi Māori that was developed by Māori for kāinga, hapori and iwi.

Te Mātāwai met with all stakeholders nationwide to gather feedback on Māori language initiatives in homes and communities, their aspirations for te reo Māori and the role of Te Mātāwai in realising these aspirations. The feedback informed the development of the Maihi Māori 2017-2040 Strategy.

Mema Pae Motuhake mõ Te Kāhui ā-rohe o ngā iwi o Mātaatua

Expressions of interest are sought for a connected, enthusiastic, highly organised Pae Motuhake member (kāhui advisory) to work alongside Te Pae Motuhake o Mātaatua and provide Māori language specific support that helps contribute to the revitalisation of te reo Māori, for Māori, by Māori across the Kāhui ā-rohe o Mātaatua.

Pae Motuhake provide iwi, regional and community leadership to help achieve the vision of Te Mātāwai.

As a member of a Pae Motuhake you will work collectively to:

- provide positive leadership of te reo Māori at local and regional levels
 - including making candidate recommendations of governance positions on the Boards of Te Taura Whiri i te Reo Māori, Te Māngai Pāho and the Māori Television Service
- develop a work programme and an annual Investment Plan including priorities for your rohe
 - designed to meet regional priorities for language revitalisation
 - aligned to the Maihi Māori
- review and assess funding applications for investment support and make recommendations on who should get support.
- use research and local experience to inform decisions made about Māori language revitalisation in your rohe
- provide quality advice and recommendations to the Te Mātāwai Board on significant issues.
- support whānau, hapū, iwi and the wider community to determine and achieve their Māori language aspirations, with a particular focus on the iwi in Mātaatua.

About you

You will be a self-directed and motivated individual:

- with an interest and experience in Māori language and development,
- with experience in planning and goal completion,
- with excellent communication skills
- with Māori language proficiency combined with an understanding of tikanga and Treaty of Waitangi principles,
- with a collaborative approach and interpersonal style that enables you to build positive working relationships with the Pae Motuhake members, kāhui, Board and Tari,
- who has familiarity and is actively engaged with the people (including the culture and language) of the Mātaatua Kāhui-ā-rohe.
